WHO CAN APPLY

Herren Project After-Prom & Graduation grants are available to any high school or preparatory school in the United States.

To be eligible, schools must host an event promoting substance free activities and healthy choices following a prom or graduation and demonstrate a financial need.

Three schools will be chosen with a combined grant amount of \$2,250.

First place - \$1,000

Second place - \$750

Third place - \$500

HOW TO APPLY

- Submit an overview of your event, including the theme, promotion plan, and detailed budget.
- Show how the grant money will be allocated or to introduce a new idea.
- Photos of past events may be submitted.

Deadline:

Applications must be submitted by **March 13, 2026, 5 pm ET.**

All applications are reviewed by our scholarship committee. Recipients will be notified by March 24, 2026.

Scholarship recipients will be featured on the Herren Project website, social media, and newsletters.
