WHO CAN APPLY?

Herren Project is pleased to recognize three students with a combined scholarship award of \$2,500. Two scholarships will be awarded for \$1,000 and one will be awarded for \$500.

The scholarship is open to all high school students who have been involved in promoting education and awareness of substance use disorder and are furthering their education at a trade school, community college or 4 year university.

To be eligible, high school seniors must have participated in Herren Project's national awareness campaign. Applicants must show a leadership role in implementing Herren Project's program at their school, planning and/or have spearheaded a substance-free event.

WHO WE ARE

Herren Project was founded in 2011 by former professional basketball player, Chris Herren, with the goal of helping others navigate the road to recovery from the disease of addiction. Herren Project has since helped thousands of individuals and their families with treatment navigation and family support services as well as brought awareness to substance use prevention.

HOW TO APPLY

Students are asked to write an essay explaining how they championed going purple within their community or school and what going purple has meant for them personally. The essay should not exceed 550 words.

Applications must be submitted by 3pm EST on April 29, 2019 to be considered. All applications will be reviewed and the scholarship recipients will be notified on May 20, 2019. Additionally, the winners will be featured on Herren Project's website with their essay and photo.
