Herren Project is proud to support schools and communities hosting safe, substance-free events to celebrate prom and graduation. This grant helps cover costs of after-prom and after-graduation parties that encourage healthy choices and inspire substance-free fun.

WHO CAN APPLY

Herren Project After-Prom & Graduation Grants are open to any high school and/or preparatory school within the United States. To be eligible, schools must host an event promoting substance-free activities and healthy choices following a prom or graduation.

Three schools will be chosen with a combined grant amount of \$3,500.

The winning school will be awarded \$2,000. The second place winner will be awarded \$1,000 and the third place winner will be awarded \$500.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit an overview of your event, including the theme, how it will be promoted and a detailed budget. Show how the grant money will be allocated or to introduce a new idea. Photos of past events may be submitted.

Applications must be submitted by 3pm EST on **March 27, 2020**. All applications will be reviewed by our grant committee and recipients will be notified by April 6th, 2020. Winners will be featured on the Herren Project website and newsletters.
