WHO CAN APPLY?

Herren Project is pleased to recognize three schools with a combined grant of \$3,500.

The winning school will be awarded \$2,000 to help support substance-free prom activities and/or an after prom or graduation party. The second place winner will be awarded \$1,000 and the third place winner will be awarded \$500.

Herren Project Purple & Proud grant is open to any high school and/or prep school across the United States. To be eligible, schools must host an after prom or graduation party promoting substance-free activities and healthy decision making.

Please join Herren Project to promote safe, substance-free after prom parties and graduation celebrations nationwide.

Applicants must submit an overview of their event and explain how the theme of the event will be promoted. All applications must include a budget detailing how the grant money will be allocated to enhance your current plans or to introduce a new idea to your school/community.

All applications must be submitted by 3pm EST on **March 29, 2019** and recipients of the award will be notified on April 8th, 2019. The school name and photo will be featured on Herren Project's website.
