Two **\$1,000 scholarships** are awarded annually to qualified recipients from across the United States.

WHO CAN APPLY

Herren Project's mission is to support, inspire and empower those affected by substance use disorder. We are also committed to preventing the misuse of substances, encouraging wellness and celebrating the power of being YOU.

All applicants must demonstrate a leadership role in the prevention and awareness of substance use disorder within their school and/or local community.

Herren Project's Scholarship Program is open to all high school seniors who plan to further their education at a trade school, community college or four-year university.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit an essay showing how you have embodied one or more parts of Herren Project's mission. Essays should not exceed 550 words. All applications must include a recommendation from a teacher, advisor or adult mentor.

Applications must be submitted by 3pm ET on **May 1, 2020**. They will be reviewed by our scholarship committee and recipients will be notified by May 22, 2020. Scholarship recipients will be featured on the Herren Project website and newsletters.
